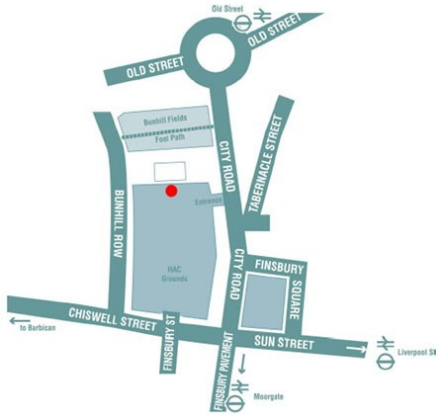
Jason Hart
